3. CITY / COUNTRY INFORMATION

3.1 About City

4. HOW TO GET TO Bielsko-Biała

4.1 By Airplane

- **Katowice Airport (KTW)** - The nearest major airport to Bielsko-Biała is Katowice Airport, approximately 90 kilometers away. It offers numerous international and domestic flights. From the airport, you can take a direct bus or a train to Bielsko-Biała, or rent a car for a convenient drive.
- **Kraków Airport (KRK)** - Another nearby airport is John Paul II Kraków-Balice International Airport, located about 100 kilometers from Bielsko-Biała. It serves many international destinations and is well-connected by bus and train services to Bielsko-Biała.
- **Ostrava Airport (OSR)** - Located in the Czech Republic, approximately 130 kilometers from Bielsko-Biała, Ostrava Airport is another option. You can take a bus or train to the Polish border and then continue to Bielsko-Biała.

4.2 Train and bus

- **Bielsko-Biała City** is well-connected by train to major Polish cities. Direct trains run from cities such as Warsaw, Kraków, Katowice. The main train station, Bielsko-Biała Główna, is centrally located and provides easy access to the city.
- **International Trains** - For travelers coming from neighboring countries, there are international train connections from cities like Vienna, Prague, Ostrava and Berlin to major Polish cities, where you can transfer to a direct train to Bielsko-Biała. Language

The official language of is Polish. English is widely spoken, especially among younger people and in major tourist areas, hotels, and restaurants.

The official currency of Poland is the Polish Zloty, abbreviated as PLN.

Bielsko-Biała hosts branches of major Polish banks such as PKO Bank Polski, Bank Pekao, mBank, Santander Bank Polska, and ING Bank Śląski. These banks offer a range of financial services. Banks generally operate Monday to Friday: 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM, Saturday: 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM (some branches may be closed). All banks are closed on Sunday, and national holidays.

Taxes

VAT (23 %) is collected in the entire country for all services and products. Tax free shopping is available to international guests only at licensed stores. A passport is required when shopping tax free.

Poland is located in the Cente region of Europe, borders on the west side with Germany, Czech Republic to the southwest, on the south side – Slovakia, east side – Ukraine, northeast – Belarus, north - Lithuania and Russia (Kaliningrad Oblast). It also has a coastline along the Baltic Sea to the north.
