





THE CEREMONIES



To celebrate the athletes from all over the world and this international competition, highlights will be organised

Opening ceremony

To officially launch the start of the competitions, the opening ceremony will be held on **Sunday 4 June 2023** in the centre of Vichy. The provisional format that could be proposed consists of a parade of the different nations in the town centre of Vichy.

The departure and arrival of the parade could be organised at the **Palais des Congrès-Opéra** de Vichy with a parade through the streets of Vichy and the Parc des Sources.

The Palais des Congrès-Opéra de Vichy is a unique journey through the Second Empire, the Belle Epoque and Modernity. Housed in a listed historic monument, the Vichy Convention and Opera House underwent a major programme in 1995 to restore the historic rooms to their original condition and to create contemporary spaces.

Inaugurated in 1903, the Vichy Opera House is the work of the architect Charles Le Coeur, who was the architect of the Ministry of the Interior and designed the typology of certain Parisian high schools, including Louis-Le-Grand and Fénelon. For the construction of the Opera, he was assisted by Lucien Woog, a Belgian architect and teacher at the Ecole des Arts Décoratifs.

A listed monument and a unique testimony to the "Art Nouveau" period, it presents a marvellous decoration in a harmony of gold, ivory and yellow.





THE CEREMONIES



Closing ceremony

In order to **congratulate, thank and celebrate** all the athletes, officials and volunteers who participated in the 6th edition of the Virtus Global Games 2023, the closing ceremony could be held at the Théâtre de Verdure in Vichy, an emblematic venue for concerts, shows and other cultural performances

There will be **performances** and a parade of flag bearers.

Finally, there will be a food court with various specialities, and a firework display at the end of the evening.

This amphitheatre, which dates from 1964, is anchored in the 120-hectare Pierre-Coulon Park. When it was first built, it was used for open-air performances: theatre, music, etc. Renovation work has enabled the site to be reconfigured to host large-scale events with an adapted stage and a larger capacity of **3,400 spectators**.

AIRPORT AND TRANSFER

Vichy is a central city and can be reached by various means of public transport.

The delegations will arrive at the various airports located near Vichy: **Clermont-Ferrand, Lyon or Geneva.**

The transport of the delegations will be provided by the organisers as soon as they arrive on French soil.

The delegations will be taken to their accommodation or to the Virtus Global Games 2023 village.

Transport will also be provided throughout the competitions, catering and accommodation.

Return airport transfers will also be provided.

Depending on your country, a **VISA** will be required to enter France. Do not hesitate to ask your local authorities for information.





LOCAL TRANSPORTATION


The banks of the Allier river, the various districts, the sports venues and the accommodation are accessible by various means

Vichy is a small town (550 hectares) and can be explored in all directions and very easily. Through the parks, around the lake, in the streets or on the water! For those who don't want to walk, cycle or pedal, the public transport network serves the various districts of Vichy. During the summer months, the free La Mouette shuttle bus allows you to go from one bank of the Allier to the other, to reach the Hippodrome or the Parc Omnisports for example, while the little tourist train runs through the town.

In line with sustainable development and complementary to other mobility solutions in the area, bicycle hire is a service offered by the Vichy Communauté from the MOBIVIE kiosk, located at Vichy station.

For an hour, a day or the whole year, VIVÉLO is the daily answer to your needs for sustainable and economical travel:

- Personalized provision of a classic, electric, children's or folding bicycle
- Free provision of all safety equipment (helmet, waistcoat, anti-theft device)
- Secure bike parking for your vivelo or your personal bike
- Reduced rate for MOBIVIE, Trans'Allier or TER subscribers.











THE HERITAGE



The town of Vichy has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 24 July 2021. In addition to the competition, discover

Activities to explore

The natural source of Vichy's most famous water and the only one to be bottled. The spring takes its name from a 15th century convent built on the rock, of which only a section of wall remains today. The water gushes out of the cracks in the aragonite rock. The spring pavilion, in neo-Louis XVI style, was built in 1908. Free tasting.

The Swiss or English colonial style chalets, built in 1863 and 1864 at the request of Napoleon III, welcomed the Emperor and his imperial suite during his stays in Vichy. In the immediate vicinity, on rue Alquié, the series of English-style houses with their characteristic bow windows housed the officers of the Imperial Guard.

Parcs d'Allier, created under Napoleon III, as well as the squares, gardens and green spaces represent 1/6th of the total surface area of the city. The Napoleon III park is particularly noteworthy, with a surface area of 7.8 hectares and 138 species. Below the dike, the Célestins beach, the guinguettes and the minigolfs welcome you.
