Classification is the cornerstone of Parakarate competitions; it determines which athletes are eligible to compete in a sport and how athletes are grouped together for competition. It aims to minimize the impact of the impairment on athletes' performance ensuring the integrity and credibility of the competition.

The Classifier are the officials who are educated, trained, and certified to conduct the classification evaluation process.

Eligibility

- Must have a high level of oral and written English.
- Must have 1 of the below requirements...
 - Certified medical professional currently working with individuals who have physical Impairments in their clinical practice.
 - Experience in the evaluation of impairments and activity limitations, such as amputation, orthopedic musculoskeletal conditions, and neurological conditions.
 - Extensive knowledge and experience in the sport of Karate.
 - Knowledge & experience of the competition consistent with WKF Competition Rules.

Level II

CLASSIFIER COURSE LEVEL II

Eligibility

The candidate for classifier must be recommended by the pertinent National Federation in the application form to attend the International Classifier Training Seminar or be identified as an appropriate professional by the Head of the classification in areas where there is a need for international classifiers.

Medical Classifier

• A certified health professional in a field relevant to the Impairment category

Technical Classifier

- An extensive coaching or another relevant background in the sport of Karate;
- Or, a recognized and reputable academic qualification that encompasses a requisite level of anatomical, biomechanical, and sportspecific expertise

The final evaluation will be a written and practical exam , and an interview.

*All candidates will need to provide proof that they do not hold a role within their national federation such as team doctor or physiotherapist **DATE** 1st edition in 2025

12 month experience as a level I classifier at the national level with at least 5 (de-identified and written) National Classification Evaluations


