Performance points are evaluated based on the total performance during the entire event and not by individual bout. The total is based on spot checks of performance over a number of bouts and conducted by the Tatami Manager plus one member of, or appointed by, the Referee Commission. The Referee Commission may adjust the result for the event based on particular incidents or the general consensus of the commission.

If there is no video review applied, the score of the three other roles criteria will be added, divided by three and multiplied by four to determine the performance score. If by chance a referee is not evaluated for another of the roles, the same principle is applied. (Evaluation points obtained / number of roles evaluated.)

Referees that register to an event and without a valid excuse do not attend, or leave before the event is finished, will lose the same number of points in the ranking as the attendance points applicable to the event.
